National School of Drama, Mumbai Centre, invites applications for the **Advance Weekend Acting Course (Part-Time, Non-Residential)** to be conducted entirely at the NSD Mumbai Centre at the address mentioned above.

This weekend foundation programme aims to train students in the fundamentals of acting, movement, voice, imagination, and theatre practices. The course will commence in **April 2026**, with a total intake of 25 seats per batch. The medium of instruction will be Hindi/English.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

Essential Qualifications

1. 10+2 from any recognized board.
2. Participation in at least Two theatre/play/short film/video production (attach certificate, brochure, leaflet, clipping, or link, etc.).
3. Working knowledge of Hindi/English.
4. Age limit: 18 to 60 years.

SELECTION PROCESS

- Interviews for shortlisted candidates will be conducted at the Mumbai Centre.
- Candidates will be informed of the Interview schedule through email and via the NSD website.
- Study material and guidelines for interview will be uploaded on 01.04.2026.
- No TA/DA or accommodation will be provided for any stage of the selection process.

- An Expert Committee constituted by NSD will assess the aptitude and suitability of the candidates. Its decision will be final and binding.
- Any canvassing shall lead to immediate disqualification. All legal disputes will fall under the jurisdiction of the High Court of Delhi.

FEE STRUCTURE

- **Selected candidates must pay a total fee of ₹35,000/- (for new candidates).**
- **A fee of ₹30,000/- is applicable for candidates who have successfully completed the Weekend Acting Course in Dramatics.**

Students selected for admission must maintain physical and mental fitness throughout the course.
